# **Swiftmile Hub**

As time goes on, if there is demand and support, the mobility hub may include other elements:


- Carshare (Zipcar)


## Notes:

- This hub aims to be located in either Central or South Oakland, in an area that has poor access to frequent transit.
- Locations were chosen according to hub restrictions (next page), as well as an effort to have the hub centrally located for residents living far away from the Fifth/Forbes corridor.
- We hope to have this station serve a large number of residents in this area of Oakland




## **Hub Restrictions:**

- Can only be located in non-residential zoning
- Must draw power from adjacent street lights
- Should be located next to **frequent-service transit**
- Should be adequate space for plenty of amenities
- Should be in an area that is **highly used and trafficked**
- Must preserve access to buildings, driveways, utilities, and transit
- Either located in parking lane (preferred) or on the sidewalk w/ at least 6' of clearance



# **Other Notes:**


- Swiftmile hubs can be piloted as a temporary location.
   However, we'd like to avoid moving them frequently which incurs costs.
- Scooters will be free-range, they won't need to be parked at a swiftmile station, though the user will receive a discount if they do.
- There are many other levers to ensure that an area has access to scooters, such as deployment points, deployment minimums, parking corrals, etc. which we will use in all of South Oakland.




# **Proposed Locations**

# Site #1 (Ward @ Semple)



#### Pros:

- Numerous points-of-interest in the area (convenience store, laundry, restaurants)
- Densely populated here
- Somewhat centrally located

### Cons:

 In a generally less visible location; "tucked-away"



## Site #2


### (Juliet @ Blvd. of the Allies)



- Connects to a bus line
- Helpful for South Oakland community

#### Cons:

- Close to dangerous high-volume streets: Blvd and Bates St.
- Few points-of-interest
- Less densely populated
- May have cars park on either side; less visibility
