This project is for bridge preservation work on the 30th Street bridge and partial preservation work on the River Avenue Viaduct. The structures provide the only motorized access to Washington's Landing (Herr's Island). This project will preserve the functional integrity of the bridges and maintain the current level of vehicular and pedestrian services.

Work on this project will focus on the deck surface. Work includes the replacement of expansion dams, pavement relief joints, barrier spall repairs, barrier replacements, sidewalk repairs, streetlights, and latex modified concrete overlay.

A future project will focus on the substructure components of the bridge.
