
- Deteriorated roadway

- Sidewalk and Curb





Project Overview - Extents




Project Overview – Scope of Work

- Reconstructed brick roadway surface
 - New brick pavers
 - Removal of deteriorated trolley tracks
- Concrete curb
- Sidewalk



Project Overview – Anticipated Phasing

- 2023 – Spring Garden to Tripoli
 - Depending on bidding results
- 2024 – Tripoli to Phineas
 - Assuming dedicated funding to complete
 - Otherwise, likely Tripoli to Suismon, with remainder done in 2025
