

- Sidewalk and Curb

















1939 drawing showing Chestnut Street roadway reconstruction

Project Overview - Extents





Project Overview - Scope of Work

- Reconstructed brick roadway surface
 - New brick pavers
 - Removal of deteriorated trolley tracks
- Concrete curb
- Sidewalk





Project Overview - Anticipated Phasing

- 2023 Spring Garden to Tripoli
 - Depending on bidding results
- 2024 Tripoli to Phineas
 - Assuming dedicated funding to complete
 - Otherwise, likely Tripoli to Suismon, with remainder done in 2025
