




Project Background — Goals

 Park Master Plan (EPMP)






William Street — Overview



- Traverses Mt.
 Washington from
 Arlington Ave to Bailey
 Ave
- Crosses over Liberty Tunnel
- Parallels PJ McArdle Roadway









William Street — Rationale

- Aging Infrastructure failure
- Encroaching landslides
- 2018 landslide finally necessitated closure





William Street—Temporary Road



Connect Cola-Neff

- Temporary Only In Grandview Park
- Provides Access to Cola
 St during construction








William Street— Mitigation measures



Rock Catchment Ditch

Retains falling rocks

One exists on site already, it will be cleaned out








William Street — Mitigation measures



Retaining Wall

Supports grade separations on steep slopes








William Street— Mitigation measures



Soil nails

Reinforces steep soil slopes








William Street— Mitigation measures



Rock lining

Protects soil from eroding on steep slopes







William Street — Limit of Disturbance



- The limit of disturbance (LOD) is the area in which all construction, material storage, and other related activities may occur
- Tree trimming/cutting will be restricted to the LOD






Cola Street — Construction Detour



- Temporary access via E Sycamore Street and Lava Street
- Traffic Control will be Design-Build developed by Contractor and submitted to City for approval prior to implementing.
- Accommodations will be made by Contractor for Residents at 111 and 121 William Street



Existing routeDetours





William Street — Converted Trail



William Street Trail, Typical Section

• Stabilize remaining width and establish a Trail for pedestrians / bicycles









Cola Street—Street Rehab



Cola Street rehabilitation, typical section

- Anchor retaining wall
- Safety improvements will allow firetrucks to turn onto Cola Street








William Street — Ecological Stabilization Elements




- Trees and plantings coordinated with City
- Taller trees planted at base to screen walls
- Live stake plantings on rock linings
